

ACADEMIC AFFAIRS COMMITTEE BY-LAWS

Article I: Purpose

Section 101

The purpose of the Academic Affairs Committee shall be to schedule academic events, act as a student liaison between the students and faculty, increase student-professor interaction, and to assist ECOS organizations with academic programs.

Article II: Membership and Voting

Section 201

The committee shall consist of:

- 1) ECOS Vice President of Academic Affairs who shall act as chairperson
- 2) Four Senators from the Student Senate
- 3) Six members at-large, appointed by the ECOS Vice President of Academic Affairs with the approval of the Student Senate.

Section 202

- A. Each member of the committee shall have one vote on all decisions.
- B. The chairperson shall vote only in the case of a tie.

Section 203

In the case of an emergency, the chairperson may take a committee vote via telephone or email.

Article III: Meetings

Section 301

Meetings for this committee should occur bimonthly. They may determine to meet more frequently depending on business. The chairperson is responsible for making the agenda for all meetings.

Article IV: Programming

Section 401

This committee shall be the sole organization responsible for the planning, organizing, and executing of academic events. Palmetto Productions and the Academic Affairs Committee are encouraged to cooperate on all events of this nature, including any responsibilities concerned with the planning, organizing, and executing of such events.

Section 402

This committee shall also be in charge of facilitating interaction between the student body and faculty as well as other Eckerd College employees. Planning for these events is determined by the committee through normal procedures.

Article V: Amendment of By-Laws

Section 501

These by-laws may be amended by 2/3 vote of its members and approval by the Student Senate.
