

Culture Council Committee By-Laws

Article I

Section 101

This Group shall be known as the ECOS Culture Council Committee.

Section 102: Statement of Purpose

The ECOS Culture Council Committee shall be in charge of coordinating ECOS efforts with the cultural clubs as well as creating events and propose policy changes that are centered around diversity, equity, and inclusion.

Article II

Section 301

The Culture Council Committee will be required to meet once a week to update everyone on current projects and air any issues, complaints, or concerns.

Section 302

Culture Council Committee members are expected to serve for the entire academic year.

Section 303

Culture Council Committee members must spend 1-2 hr per week in the Diversity and Inclusion Office

Section 304

If a Culture Council Committee member decides to resign, the Culture Council Liaison must inform the student body of the vacancy and make applications available to all interested parties.

Article II

Section 401

The Culture Council Committee will be required to meet once a week to update everyone on current projects and air any issues, complaints, or concerns.

Section 402

Culture Council Committee members are expected to serve for the entire academic year.

Section 403

Culture Council Committee members must spend 1-2 hr per week in the Diversity and Inclusion Office

Section 404

If a Culture Council Committee member decides to resign, the Culture Council Liaison must inform the student body of the vacancy and make applications available to all interested parties.

Article IV

Section 501

A quorum of at least four committee members, including the Culture Council Liaison, is necessary for any business to take place.

Article V

Section 601

An amendment to the Culture Council Committee By-Laws can be made with a two-thirds vote of the Student Senate.
