

## Environmental Responsibility Committee By Laws

### Article I. Name

1. The name of this committee shall be ECOS Environmental Responsibility, hereinafter referred to as the Environmental Responsibility Committee.

### Article II. Purpose and Philosophy

1. The purpose of this committee shall be to
  1. Raise awareness of environmental issues and introduce potential solutions
  2. Implement environmental aspects to campus with the Green Fund
  3. Communicate and collaborate with professionals and officials of Eckerd in order to approve events and modifications to campus.
  4. Engage the student body of Eckerd in improving the sustainability of Eckerd College through the projects and initiatives of the Environmental Responsibility Committee.
2. The philosophy of this committee should be followed by all members
  1. Littering should not be done by anyone on the committee.
  2. A conscious effort should be made to recycle cardboard and bottles/cans, reduce waste, and compost food scraps. Members should also attempt to promote these behaviors in other Eckerd students.
  3. Should always be mindful of ways to reduce the environmental impacts of their daily lives. An example of this is to turn off the water when brushing teeth.
  4. Help (gently) inform others on how they can improve their actions
  5. Spread awareness of environmental issues as well as promote the projects and initiatives of the Environmental Responsibility Committee.

### Article III. Membership

1. The committee shall be comprised of:
  1. A Chairperson appointed by the ECOS President-Elect and approved by the Student Senate.
  2. 15 members at-large appointed by the ECOS President and approved by the Student Senate.
  3. Any volunteers for miscellaneous events and modifications to campus. For example, a beach clean up would accept any volunteers.

### Article IV. Chairperson

1. The Chairperson of the Environmental Responsibility Committee shall:
  1. Call and oversee meetings no less than once a week during the academic year.
  2. Oversee funding for the committee
  3. Oversee publicity of events
