

PUBLIC RELATIONS COMMITTEE BYLAWS

Article I: Purpose

A. Section 101

The purpose of this committee shall be to assist with the publication and advertisement of any event sponsored by ECOS or the Student Senate, assist in communications between all parties at Eckerd College, assist in the publication of the ECOS newsletter, website, and event schedules, and assist in posting materials and their removal from campus information centers.

Article II: Membership and Voting

A. Section 201

The committee shall consist of:

1. Chairperson, who shall be appointed by the ECOS President-elect and the outgoing chairperson
2. Four Senators from the Student Senate
3. Four members at-large appointed by the Finance Director with the approval of the student senate
4. One Palmetto Chair
5. One Media Committee Member
6. ECOS President

B. Section 202

1. Each member of the committee shall have one vote on all decisions
2. The chairperson shall vote only in the case of a tie

C. Section 203

In the case of an emergency, the chairperson may take a committee vote via telephone or email.

Article III: Meetings

A. Section 301

Meetings for this committee should occur weekly. They may determine to meet more frequently depending on business. The chairperson is responsible for making the agenda for all meetings.

Article IV: Responsibilities of Members

A. Section 401

This committee shall be the sole organization responsible for the publicity of all events sponsored by ECOS and the Student Senate. Each committee member shall be assigned a specific task that they will perform on a weekly basis. Some of these tasks may include, but are not limited to, making posters, the distribution of flyers, posters, etc, media publicity contact, and the removing all advertising from walls, tables, etc.

B. Section 402

This committee shall also be responsible for advertising of the ECOS Newsletter and the ECOS Page in the Triton. This committee should stay informed of committee events and other functions of ECOS when publishing in these mediums. If they wish to substitute other avenues for these sources, they may do so by the majority vote.

Article V: Amendment of By-Laws

Section 501

These by-laws may be amended by $\frac{2}{3}$ vote of its members and approval by the Student Senate.
